Frankfurt, December 2020 – Instead of the cancelled international roadshow 2020/2021 to the fashion weeks in Vancouver, Addis Ababa, Paris, and Kiev, the **FRANKfurtstyleaward 2020** titled "**BENEFITS of CHANGE**" goes into extension and stays in Frankfurt as a harbinger of Frankfurt Fashion Week, July 2021. Thanks to the invitation of **Mirek Macke, initiator, director and curator of the <u>Kunstverein Familie Montez</u> (KVFM), the International Talent Contest for Fashion & Design is honored with the exhibition of this year's TOP10 Winners Collection as start of a series of installations from the "Best of..." of past awards which meet the criteria uniqueness, sustainability, innovation, craftsmanship and art.**

Due to the worldwide Corona pandemic, the award ceremony and finale show of the FRANKfurtstyleaward 2020 with the motto "BENEFITS of CHANGE" was broadcasted as a hybrid event with live stream from the Airport Club Frankfurt on June 27, 2020 instead of at the consumer show Tendence of Messe Frankfurt.

The international expert jury selected the ten winners of the international Talent Contest for Fashion & Design from the TOP60 finalists from 17 countries, who presented their submissions for the first time in self-created video clips.
